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SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

Four Scholarships of \$1,500 each will be awarded for the Academic School Year ending June of the year of the application. Applicants will be judged on the basis of class standing, citizenship, and leadership. A professional staff from the 200 Club will process the applications and be the sole judge of the final awards. (No members of the Jersey City Lodge #4 will be involved in the judgment of the award)

TO QUALIFY

A parent must be an active member in good standing of the Jersey City F.O.P. Lodge #4.

Diploma Requirements: The applicant must be a bona fide student of a private, parochial of public school, and must be eligible to receive a high school diploma prior to July 1ST of the year of application.

The applicant must have definite plans to pursue a post-high school program of education or training, on a full time basis.

The applicant must have exhibited good citizenship traits and be of sound moral character.
